



Fred Bunn Multi-Use Trails

Please be advised that the trails are currently under construction and are not complete. Use finished segments of trail at your own risk. All trail rules and etiquette apply during construction. If a trail user encounters construction activity while using the park, they are asked to avoid the area and find an alternate pathway to use.

Trail Rules & Etiquette

- Share the trails. This multi-use trail is designed for walkers, hikers, runners and bikers.
- Please stay off wet and muddy trails to avoid causing damage to the trail system. If you're leaving footprints or ruts in the trail, that means the trail is too wet for use.
- When you're using the trail, practice the "leave no trace" code of conduct and don't litter or modify the trail in any way.
- For everyone's safety, keep to the right of the trail except when passing.
- Cyclists and mountain bikers must yield to hikers, runners and walkers. Before passing, slow down and establish verbal contact with other trail users indicating your intent to pass. A bike bell is highly encouraged to alert other trail users you are approaching.
- **Don't block the trail.** If you have to stop along the trail, move yourself, your pet, bike and other personal items completely off the trail to avoid getting in other people's way.
- Trail conditions and specific situations are unique and will dictate whether you need to stop, step off the trail or simply smile and say "hello" as you pass each other.
- **Pets must be secured on a 6-foot leash at all times. Please clean up after your pets.**
