Water Supply Survey

Dear East Grand Rapids Resident/Property Owner:

The City of East Grand Rapids Department of Public Works and the city's contractor, PowerVac, will be in your neighborhood performing a drinking water supply system survey. This survey is being performed to improve and maintain the drinking water supply system in your neighborhood starting this winter/spring.

The survey consists of using pressurized water and a vacuum truck to temporarily remove soil around elements of the water supply system and gathering information concerning water service valves, water service boxes, water service material type (copper, lead, plastic, other) and condition. Once the survey information has been recorded the small access excavation will be filled with sand and gravel. Restorations will settle over time so the Department of Public Works staff will monitor and return to fill accordingly. **This work will take place in your driveway approach where your water service box is located.** The City will work with a concrete contractor to replace the portion of your driveway affected by this work. The survey work should not impact the water service to your home or property.

If there are any issues documented during the survey the city will notify residents with a door hanger the day before their water service will be shutoff and repairs will be made to those residents' water services needing attention. This work will be taking place between the sidewalk and the center of the pavement in most instances, and last one day in front of each property.

If the survey work determines that a water service line serving your property is lead, a notification will be provided to you along with additional information. For more information regarding public utilities, please visit the public works page of the city website.
